| 2. | ___ | ___ | 1% hydrocortisone cream for skin itchiness. |
| 3. | ___ | ___ | Acetaminophen 325 mg or 650 mg one time per day for headache, dysmenorrhea, elevated temperature (over 101 degrees), or for muscular pains. In instances where parent permission is not on file, careful discretion must be used when dispensing this medication. |
| 4. | ___ | ___ | Ibuprofen 200 mg tabs for dysmenorrhea, headaches or muscular pains. Give 1-2 tablets one time per day. In instances where parent permission is not on file, careful discretion must be used when dispensing this medication. |
| 5. | ___ | ___ | Coke syrup, 2 drams for nausea. |
| 6. | ___ | ___ | Pepto-Bismol (or generic equivalent) 1 TBS for relief of gastric symptoms. One dose only. |
| 7. | ___ | ___ | Magnesium/aluminum hydroxide/simethicone, 1 TBS for relief of gastric symptoms. One dose only, or Calcium Carbonate (Maalox tablets), 2 tablets one time per day for relief of gastric symptoms. |
| 8. | ___ | ___ | Administer the EpiPen 0.3mg when dyspnea, rapid pulse, cyanosis, convulsions or unconsciousness occur following insect stings. |
| 9. | ___ | ___ | Sting relief swab for insect bites. |
| 10. | ___ | ___ | Betadine for cleansing abrasions and lacerations. |
| 11. | ___ | ___ | Oral anesthetic for minor toothaches and gum irritation. |
| 12. | ___ | ___ | Benadryl as per package instructions for allergic reactions. |
